CALL TO ORDER/PLEDGE OF ALEGANCE 6:30PM Guest Count 2 Resident Count 15

LaBoda moved to approve the agenda, supported by Iutzi, All in favor. **MC**

Treasurer's report read by Duby, motion to approve by Conway, 2<sup>nd</sup> by LaBoda All in favor. **MC**

Reading of July minutes by LaBoda, motion to approve by Iutzi 2<sup>nd</sup> by Conway All in favor. **MC**

Invoices read by LaBoda motion to approve and pay bills by Duby, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Iutzi All in favor. **MC**

**Guest: Cory Barz, Clare County Transit** representative gave a presentation on the history and services of the transit and answered questions. **Sandy Bristol, County Commissioner** gave updates on county business including; There will be a Land Sale at the Doherty Hotel on August 4<sup>th</sup>. The Animal Shelter is getting a much needed new truck. Gerrymandering will be on the ballot in November. Progress is being made establishing a Violence Prevention Coalition. There will be a guest speaker at the October MTA meeting regarding Medical Marijuana.

**Public Comments: Bob Bess** expressed concern over how the stumps were left in a mess after the road work was done on Athey Ave. **Mark Robinson** was also concerned with stumps on the power line and that the black silt fence by Cranberry Creek is not working as it should.

**Linda Barkell, Planning Commission Secretary** stated they met on July 10<sup>th</sup> and continued discussing green burials and cemetery ordnances. There will be a Rummage/Craft Sale fundraiser for the park on Saturday September 1<sup>st</sup> and Mr. Vetoes will be the food vender. Spaces are \$15 and includes a meal ticket. Meal tickets are \$10. The Park Fund was able to purchase a lot of equipment, fencing and two pavilions from Harrison Community Schools that is located at Amble Elementary for \$500.

**Mark Janeczko, Zoning & Blight Enforcement** stated he issued 4 new permits and sent letters on an abandoned house. Incoming complaints include, barking dogs, scrappers, sewage, and abandon cars.

**New Business:** The raise for the Deputy Clerk and Deputy Treasurer had been tabled. Conway moved to increase both deputies pay by \$750 annually. Supported by Duby, All in favor. **MC** Final brining for 2018 will be done on August 21.

**Old Business:** Work on the north end of the building will begin the end of August. Surveyors are working on the cemetery. Siren did not sound.

Conway moved to adjourn at 7:40pm supported by Iutzi, all in favor. **MC**
