BOARD MEETING MINUTES

CALL TO ORDER/PLEDGE OF ALEGANCE 6:30PM Guest Count 3 Resident Count 9

Present: Conway, Duby, Iutzi, LaBoda, Wright

Conway moved to approve the agenda, supported by LaBoda, All in favor. **MC**

Treasurer's report read by Duby, motion to approve by LaBoda, 2nd by Iutzi All in favor. **MC**

Reading of October minutes by LaBoda, motion to approve by Iutzi 2nd by Conway All in favor. **MC**

Reading of special meeting 10/30/19 on Recreational Marijuana Ordinance – prohibit, motion to approve by Conway, supported by Duby All in favor. **MC**

Invoices read by LaBoda, motion to approve and pay bills including incoming bills by Iutzi, 2nd by Duby All in favor. **MC**

Guest: Mark Fitzpatrick, County Commissioner, stated that Judges met with the state regarding security issues. A resolution was passed to hold a public hearing on the BOC absorbing the Road Commission.

Two public hearings are scheduled at the Court House on November 20 and December 18 at 9am.

Tim Haskin, Clare County Road Commissioner, also spoke about the issue with the Road Commission and explained why he feels the BOC should not take over the Road Commission.

Chris Damvelt, Harrison Fire Chief said things are going well and they have been working with the Red Cross for smoke detectors.

Tina Braman, Hamilton Twp. Assessor, gave a report to the board.

Public Comments: Mike Conway stated there has been issues with drones in our area flying at night and harassing wildlife.

Linda Barkell, Planning Commission Secretary stated they held a Public Hearing on the Prohibition of Recreational Marihuana Establishments on October 30th. Approximately 21 residents were present and no one spoke either for or against. The PC answered questions, explaining this ordinance is only pertaining to commercial business and does not have any effect on their home use.

Mark Janeczko, Zoning & Blight Enforcement issued 9 permits and gave information from a Sewage Conference he attended in Traverse City.

New Business: Brining for 2020 will be done on May 18 and August 20, 2020. Scrap Tire collection will be held on May 9. Board of Review will be held on December 10th at 5pm.

Old Business: Siren sounded on schedule.
