Guest: Mark Fitzpatrick, County Commissioner – Stated two new Road Commissioners have been appointed and will run for election in August. Terms will be staggered so all don't come up for re-election at the same time. Mid-Michigan College is exploring expanding boundaries. County budget is in the red over a quarter of a million.
