Tim Mclavy stated Republic does take trash to the Waste Management site. Randy Roy said he has called Republic and they have changed dumpsters for him with no problem. Dave Cooper stated Ron Bushong said if /when they get money they will stretch it as far as they can.

Committee Reports: Bob Bess, Planning Commission Chair reported they did not meet in April and that the Municipal Civil Infraction Ord. gives local law enforcement our permission to write tickets.

Old Business: Discussed property tax information look up. Checking with J. Beemer and BS&A.

MC Duby moved to move money in the budget from Parks to Hall Maintenance and Repair to cover the cost of the winter kit for the generator, supported by Iutzi, all in favor MC Budget meeting set for May 22 at 6:30.
