Mark Janeczko, Zoning Administrator/Blight Enforcement: has been busy at Lake Wobegone but still gave out eight permits and is always working on blight. Mark suggested that the PC review the entire camping ordinance before amending.

**New Business:** Motion made by Wright and supported by LaBoda to have brine application scheduled for August 20<sup>th</sup>.
